The search is on to determine how the recent drought (see below) affected milk supplies across the state. Farmers are now reporting substantially lower milk supplies for the first quarter of 2016 with several regions reporting milk volumes of just below 500 kgs per annum. Dairy Council of Victoria Executive Director Annabelle Young said, "The drought has had a strong effect on bovine health. It has been very dry, dryer than any drought we have experienced for the past 23 years. The current inversion of the atmospheric pressure in the south east of the state is unlikely to break soon. The current conditions are very similar to those of the drought of 2011 when cattle were still reliant on dry paddocks for some feed and rain became very unreliable." Ms Young said farmer's milk prices could be at one of the lowest points for the last 70 years. "In order to protect farmers from the loss of income incurred due to the drought, we are implementing a 50 per cent rebate of all Dairy Farm Debt Relief costs along with a 50 per cent rebate of the 4.25 per cent interest rate over a 10-year period. An additional 3.25 per cent rebate will be available for farmer's who meet the following criteria:
